



Dorm Internet Request Form

Connecting to The Bolles School dorm network will provide you with access to the Internet. The recommended hardware and software are as follows:

1. PC running Windows XP SP 3 or Apple running OS X
2. One (1) Cat5 Network Patch Cable
3. Student computer in good working condition. (MIS will help facilitate problems and answer questions, however MIS does not repair student computers.)
4. Anti-Virus software and host firewall protection

Upon signing this form the student should be familiar with the Dorm Network Usage Policy.

Note: If any dorm student receives a different computer than the original computer registered, then he/she will have to re-submit the Dorm Internet Request Form with their new MAC address. Failure to fully complete this form will deny privilege of access to the dorm network. (**Please make sure print is legible**)

MAC ADDRESS (Wireless) _____

(The MAC address is a hexadecimal number given to the Network Interface Card on a computer. It can be found on a computer running Microsoft Windows XP by following these directions.)

1. Click Start on the taskbar, and select Run...
2. Type cmd and click OK
3. At the command prompt type ipconfig/all
4. Locate the "Physical Address" on the "Ethernet adapter Local Area Connection:" This is your wired MAC ADDRESS
(ex. 00-D0-66-BC-A9-B8)
5. Locate the "Physical Address" on the "Wireless Network Connection:" This is your wireless MAC ADDRESS
(ex. 00-1E-66-BC-C2-B8)

(The MAC address can be found on a computer running MAC OS X Leopard by following these directions.)

1. Open System Preferences
2. Click Network
3. Click Ethernet
4. Click the Advanced button
5. Click the Ethernet tab. Next to Ethernet ID is the MAC address.
