Dear Parents of Resident Students:

Health care is always a concern when your child is away from home and I would like to take this opportunity to explain our medical services.

Medical care is provided in the School's two Health Centers by Darcy Scott, BSN, on the San Jose Campus, and Beverly Kidd, LPN, on the Bartram Campus. The Health Centers are open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on school days. In addition, our school physician, Dr. Frank Genuardi, Chief of Adolescent Medicine and Director of Student Education at the University of Florida, Jacksonville, is on campus three days a week for consultation and also provides twenty-four hour telephone coverage. These services are covered in your tuition by the clinic fee and there are no additional charges unless lab tests or prescriptions are recommended.

The School also has a network of physicians that we refer to for dental, orthodontic, optical, and specialty areas when necessary. We use physicians and pharmacies that utilize your current insurance plan whenever possible.

Enclosed are four forms that must be filled out in order to insure a safe and healthy year for your child while at Bolles. Please use black ink and print when completing these forms.

**Boarder Medical Information and Authorization**

This is our "hot sheet" and contains the student's emergency contact information, the actual Consent for Emergency Health Care, important insurance information and a little medical history.

**Authorization to Share "Protected Health Information" Form**

The recently enacted HIPAA laws have changed the way the medical profession deals with protected health information and we can not access any information, talk with a doctor's office, or discuss payment issues without this.

**Mandatory Immunization Form (New Students Only)**

(Florida Residents may substitute the blue **Florida Certificate of Immunization** form issued by local health departments and physician's offices for this form.)

Make sure this form is stamped and signed by an authorized health professional.

**Meningococcal Meningitis Information Sheet and Form (New Students Only)**

(Student must show proof of immunization against Meningococcal disease or parents must sign the waiver.)
