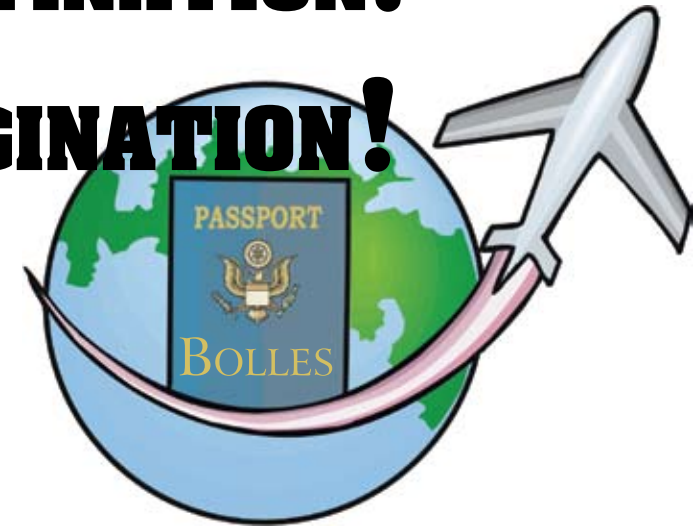

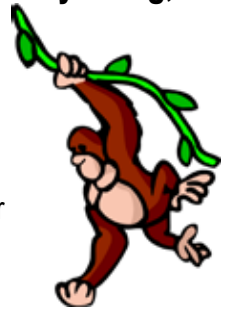
Our overnight bed space is limited to the first 30 campers who sign up, with additional campers added from a waiting list as space allows.
