## Additional Costs:

Prescribed dress for school is required for middle school (Grades 6-8) students. Clothing should be purchased from the School's approved vendor. While costs vary depending upon the selection and number of items desired, research has shown the cost to be less than the purchase of school clothing in the open retail market.

The School provides student accident insurance coverage for travel to and from school, during the school day, and for school-sponsored activities. Claim forms are available from the Finance Center.

Tuition refund insurance is required of all boarding students, new students, and any student who enters after June 25, 2010, unless tuition is paid in full and a waiver is signed. (Optional for all other students). The rates for the 2010-11 school year are as follows:

Boarding	3.33% of tuition
Day	1.62% of tuition

Students responsible for any damage to School property are expected to pay for repairs or replacement. Damage to property is always investigated before a charge is levied.
