The Bolles School Transportation Department Student Conduct Guidelines

In the interest of safety, any student who chooses to be transported in a Bolles vehicle is expected to obey the following rules at all times.

Failure to comply with any of these guidelines could result in a referral to the Dean's Office and possible disciplinary action.

- Students are required to use seatbelts when they are available.
- Students are not permitted to eat or drink anything while in the vehicle.
- Students are not permitted to chew gum.
- Students should remain seated at all times when the vehicle is in motion.
- When possible, students should place all book bags, sports bags, and equipment under the seats to keep the aisles clear.
- Inappropriate behavior such as throwing objects, rough housing, vandalism, or shouting will not be permitted.
- Students are expected to show respect to the driver and classmates at all times.
- For safety reasons bus drivers will not stop and pick up students except in designated pick-up locations. If you are late and miss the bus proceed to the next designated pick-up location on the bus route schedule.

In addition, students are reminded that they are representing The Bolles School when they are passengers in the vehicle. To this end, students are encouraged to exemplify the Bolles Values Statement in a way that will contribute positively to our community.
